

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY



Undergraduate & Graduate Academic Studies, and Graduate Research

The OAS has opened its 2025 Academic Scholarship Program for undergraduate and graduate studies or research. Scholarships are available for institutions in any OAS Member State, with preference for those in the OAS Consortium due to lower tuition rates. The funding cap is \$10,000 per year for up to two years. Applicants must apply directly to their chosen universities.

Application Process

Applicants should apply online directly through the OAS online application form: www.oas.org/scholarships

Applicants are required to also submit the following electronic documents to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Belize via email to jenina.urbina@mfa.gov.bz and copy belizemfa@btl.net.

Pre-selected candidates must be enrolled or have unconditional admission for studies starting between January and December 2026.

Required Documents for OAS Scholarship Application

- Copy of the highest degree diploma and transcript of grades for the highest degree completed or in progress or current unofficial transcript (if still enrolled).
- Registration proof or unconditional admission letter from the chosen program.
- Two recommendation forms from professors, supervisors, or business leaders, must be signed and/or stamped using the OAS forms. Cannot be from relatives.
- Curriculum Vitae (max. 2 pages) and Government-issued ID or passport.

Additional Documents for Undergraduate Applicants

- Transcript of the current Bachelor's degree program. If transferring credits for the last two years, submit Associate's degree diploma and transcripts.

Deadline is Monday 16th March 2026
